Shields: Consensus of opinion exists that the water rates should be increased

Proposed:

Minimum use charge should be raised to \$27 (under 12,000 gallons of usage) 12,000 – 29,999 gallon usage would increase 50 cents per thousand gallons over 30,000 gallons used would increase 75 cents per thousand gallons

Estimated revenue increase would be approx. \$13,000 per annum Should go into effect April 1, 2006

Manzari: Agrees that we need to plan for future contingencies by increasing water fund balance
