DISCUSSION: DANGEROUS INTERSECTION; OLD HAY BARN

Ronald Smith:

Route 90 and Indian Field Road cited as dangerous intersection

Raises question of demolishing old Town hay barn

Frank Sellen: Barn needs some repairs but is good for cold storage

Dale Sellen: We have no estimates comparing cost of repair vs. replacement

Underwood: No money in budget now for such a project Dale and Frank and the Board should look into it further

Shields: Canvassed neighbors within sight of old barn, consensus of opinion was strongly in favor of keeping barn

finding it aesthetically preferable to new construction

Ronald Smith: Believes that most people feel otherwise and would like to have it removed

Shields: We should put some doors on it
