In the early part of May, Bern, Mark and Jake started ditching and cleaning up trees and brush. Al is getting caught up on his patching and has been brooming off some of the roads that we plan on resurfacing later. After getting that done, he will be mowing steady most of the summer.

We have the culverts on Bruton Road complete. The men changed two 5-foot diameter cross culverts and one 18-inch. We also replaced some of the old driveway culverts that were rusted and thin. After some levelling, it should be ready for filtration fabric and gravel.

Frank and Jake cleaned the wood and brush out of the ditch on Route 34 from the cemetery and took three 10wheeler loads out. Albert Armstrong stopped in and was wondering if they could get a culvert pipe installed, so they could get dirt up to where they have been working.

The new IH 10-wheeler truck has been delivered and is on the road. With all but a couple of small things, it seems excellent. We still have to get radios, antennas, lettering and revolving lights installed.

Frank attended the 62nd annual highway school for highway superintendents at Ithaca College. There were many interesting classes – from road rebuilding to a lawyers' panel which covered legal aspects of the job.
